Blending the AWF yarn with non-AWF yarn products is likely to impair the general water repellent performance of the knitted fabric

While the antiwick performance of the yarn is proven, and effective at repelling spray water from the surface of knitted fabric, the product will not prevent water from passing through large physical gaps or holes contained in certain knit patterns

The product can be washed with water and mild detergent up to 40°C, however to ensure continued antiwick performance on knitted fabrics after washing, all detergents must be completely rinsed off the shoes or garments
