- demonstrate safety leadership and encourage all employees to be actively engaged in hazard identification and risk reduction initiatives.
- emphasise the importance of health and safety by including it as a Key Performance Indicator in all of our operations.
- treat violations of this Health and Safety policy and management system extremely seriously and take appropriate disciplinary action in response.
- only work with suppliers and contractors who insist on equally high standards of health and safety practices.
- ensure that risks in new operations are assessed and that appropriate mitigating actions are taken and that training is provided.
- undertake assessment of risks, control measures and culture in acquisitions during due diligence and make appropriate post-acquisition plans as a result.

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It is the primary responsibility of all business leaders and managers to ensure that health and safety is a core value in everything we do.

It is the duty of all employees to take care of their own safety and the safety of others, to co-operate and follow safety training and instructions and report hazards and unsafe conditions.
