# Connecting for growth - driving the next phase of growth at Coats

- Global mega trends positive for Coats, but industry is changing which brings new opportunities
- Now is the right time to change from a position of strength and momentum
- We will reposition Coats to achieve greater speed, agility, innovation and productivity – Talent and Technology to underpin this journey
- Connecting for Growth is a 2 year transformation programme to deliver this change, and will result in \$15m p.a. of net cost savings (by 2020) after \$10m p.a. of reinvestments
- Continued financial discipline to deliver further EPS growth and cash to reinvest in future growth


