How does Coats Core Offer application work?

Coats Core Offer application can be access from Coats eComm and Coats Industrial portal.

Access from Coats eComm


- Step 1 : Login to <u>eComm</u>.
- Step 2 : Click Core Offer in the menu bar.



Step 3: Specify up to six products to search in Coats Core Offer application. You have four different ways to search Core Offer products:



- a) By using Coats Article (e.g. 2994120) if you
- By using Coats product brand name (e.g. Epic) or substrate description (e.g. Corespun-Poly Poly
- c) By using combination of Coats brand, ticket, length and finish. (e.g. Epic, 120, 5000M, and Standard).
- d) By using combination of substrate description, ticket, length and finish. (e.g. Corespun-Poly Poly Core, 120, 5000M, and Standard).
- Step 4: Choose one of the two search buttons (Search Common Shade or Search All Shades) to display the results.
 - **Search Common Shade** To search available shade based on the combination of the inputted products.
 - **Search All Shades** To search all shades for each inputted products.



Step 5 (optional): Export the result in excel format by clicking the **Export** button.




